ColoSpace is pleased to announce it has completed a major network upgrade and expanded Layer 2 connectivity to each of its Massachusetts Data Center locations (Marlborough, Rockland, Somerville, and Waltham). By working with multiple vendors and engineering redundant paths, ColoSpace has boosted both the quality and quantity of connectivity available at each location.

The multi-gigabit links between the ColoSpace facilities allow for a host of new capabilities. Customers can leverage the connectivity for multi-site deployments and can purchase dedicated secure Ethernet connectivity between each of our facilities and utilize the private path for high speed data replication or off-site data backups. Further, all clients now have access to our full roster of 22 Telephone/Network Carriers for connectivity back to their offices or other advanced telecommunications services.

In addition to our Massachusetts upgrade, ColoSpace has also contracted with two key fiber vendors to expand the connectivity between our Massachusetts and New Hampshire sites. When this effort is complete ColoSpace will have one of the highest capacity Internet Networks in northern New England.
